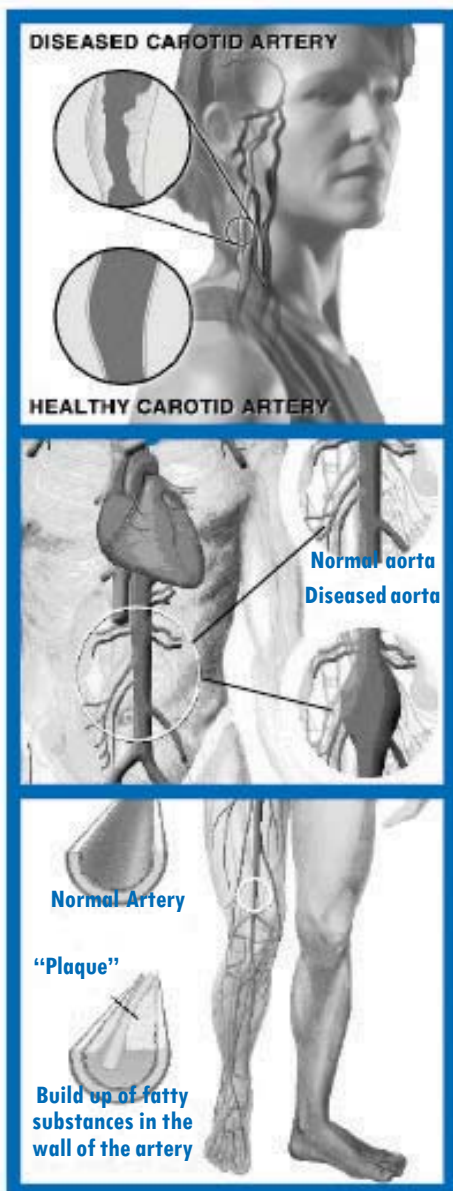

This screens for the most common irregular heart beat, which increases the risk of stroke five-fold.

3 Abdominal Aortic Aneurysm (AAA) Screening

Screens for the existence of an aneurysm in the abdominal aorta. The majority of people with an aneurysm have no symptoms.

4 Peripheral Arterial Disease (PAD) Screening

It is four to five times more likely that you will die of heart disease if you have peripheral arterial disease—plaque buildup in the arms/legs.
