- Be a resident of Pennsylvania and a member of a Fraternal Benefit Society that is a member of the Pennsylvania Fraternal Congress.
- Be a 2010 high school graduate attending an accredited college, university, trade school, etc. in the summer/fall of 2010 as a full time student (twelve semester credits).
- Obtain a recommendation letter from their Fraternal Benefit Society.
- Submit a 500-word essay on: *What does a Fraternal Benefit Society mean to you and how has your life been enriched by your involvement in your Fraternal.*

Return the completed application, essay and letter of recommendation, postmarked no later than September 1, 2010.

At least one \$500 scholarship will be awarded. Additional scholarships may be awarded depending upon available funds.
